

If you haven't come along to our bible study/fellowship groups before, this autumn might be a great time to start.

We are going to use the book and film of "The Shack" by Wm Paul Young. This will help us to explore themes such as what we believe about God and what is important in life.

We meet on Monday evenings on zoom and Tuesday mornings at Romiley Methodist Church (in the annex) and both meetings include people from different churches and would really welcome more people to join the conversation. We aim to have good discussion and it is absolutely fine to discover that we think and believe differently about things.

If you fancy joining us, it will probably be helpful to have read the book or watched the film, but it is not essential. No one is expected to have deep bible knowledge, we all just share where we are and enrich one another.

You can mix and match between zoom and in-person meetings as well – we discuss the same content but because there are different people, the conversations are often quite different.







The official date for CAP Sunday is **Sunday 13th October**, but you're welcome to choose a date that suits you and your church.


